The institute is being managed by a High Power Committee under the Chairmanship of Agriculture Production Commissioner / Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of U.P., with 13 members comprising Principal Secretaries- Planning, Technical Education, Finance and Cooperation (Govt. of UP), Commissioner & Registrar, Co-operative and Managing Directors of different Apex Institutions of Co-operative department.

PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTE

ICCMRT is mandated to offer quality education, research, consultancy and training on various issues related to cooperative and corporate management. The Institute has the following three core areas of competency:



EDUCATION - BBA, B.Com (Hons.) & MBA PROGRAM

ICCMRT started with Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDBM) and Certificate Course in Computer Application in early 90s. In 1997, it started a Two-year Full-time Post Graduate Diploma in Business Administration (PGDBA) approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India approved with the intake of 30 seats which was converted to MBA Programme, approved by AICTE and affiliated to the then Uttar Pradesh Technical University (UPTU), Lucknow now known as Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU) in 2001 with the seat intake of 60 students.

As a part of extension programme and with the growing demand of MBA course the seat intake has been increased to 120 in the year 2004, which has further increased to 180 seats in the year 2011. The admission in MBA programme takes place through National Testing Agency (NTA) and Common University Entrance Test (CUET) followed by counseling and allotment of the seat in favour of the institute. Registration of the students is made at the institute on production of the allotment letter issued by the university (AKTU) followed by all registration formalities including depositing of course fee. Our MBA programme is one of the flagship program the most preferred course among the students in the state of Uttar Pradesh.

The institute started BBA and B. Com (Hons.) courses under the academic expansion from the session 2018-19.

The MBA Programme has been designed by Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University, Lucknow to develop professional managers who can shoulder varied responsibilities in the organizations working in different sectors of our economy. Students are groomed to feel comfortable and confident while making decisions under the circumstances of risk and uncertainty and must be willing to manage risk, deal with complex situations and harmonize individual and group efforts. The emphasis is on self-learning and to promote an inquisitive and analytical mind.

The Institute plays a critical role to stimulate the students through a balance of pedagogic approaches. The institute has adapted a unique model of education that is student centric and

career oriented and application of the knowledge to create a synergetic impact that will address the high demand for professional manpower in the corporate world.

The institute has been successful in building vibrate relationship with the corporate world and has been successful in achieving more than 100% placement of the MBA Batch over the years. Students received multiple job offers over the years. The Institute arranges a campus placement drive for our MBA, BBA & B.Com (Hons.) students every year.

The highest package offered this year was by ITC-Hotels of Rs. 7.30 lacs per annum and the average package stands for Rs. 3.00 lacs per annum.

Training & Consultancy

- 9) Other specialized training program as per need of the department.

To name a few organizations and departments for which training has been organized are; UP Cooperative Bank, District Cooperative Bank, Power Corporation, Mandi Parishad, Office of Chief Inspector (offices- Prayagraj), PCF, Registration Department (Stamps and Revenue), State Council of Education Reasearch & Training (SCERT), Sarv-Shiksha Abhiyaan, Unicef, SIPSA, NHM, NRHM, Audit Officers (Local Fund), Audit Officers (Cooperative and Panchayat), ADO and ADCO (Cooperatives), Engineers (PACFED & UPCLDF), PCDF, State Ware housing corporation, Health and family welfare UP, FCI, Central Warehousing Corporation, AIDS Control Society, UP Forest Corporation. Three months' foundation/ induction training for the Inspectors of the Department of Custom, Indirect Taxes, GST and Narcotics, Stamp anf Registration, Community Resource Persons (CRPs) of UP State Rural Livelihood Mission, Various NGOs etc.

The Institute has signed an MOU with Entrepreneurship Development Institute, U.P. to conduct entrepreneurship development programs (efforts are being made to enable the MBA students to become entrepreneurs), MOU with CCS National Institute Agriculture Management (NIAM), Jaipur to conduct training to department of agriculture marketing of the state, MOU with National Institute of Agriculture Extension (MANAGE), Hyderabad as a New Nodal Training Institute under Govt. of India's Agri clinics & Agri Business Centres (AC & ABC) for organizing 45-60 days training to agriculture graduates, agri-entrepreneurs free of cost including fooding and lodging in the campus, MoU with BYS Skill Pvt. Ltd., to conduct research and training to the

personnel and common beneficiaries of various schemes of central government. The institute is also making efforts to have MoU with NABARD and Bankers Institute of Rural Development (BIRD) for training and human resource development (FPOs, other farmers' organization) along with faculty exchange program.

The institute so far has conducted 1253 training courses imparting training to 41041 officials till 31st March, 2023.

INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE INSTITUTE

The Institute is housed in its own integrated campus of 2.33 acres with a blend of architectural innovation, interiors and functional convenience. It has multi-storied separate academic, administrative and hostel buildings having centrally air conditioned seminar hall, library block, classrooms, well equipped with audio visual aid, tutorial rooms, computer labs and modern

auditorium with latest Audio-Visual facilities. The campus is well surrounded by a boundary wall and has a secured environment.

Class Rooms: The institute has 8 class rooms with average carpet area of 74 Sqm well equipped with audio visual aid and 2 tutorial rooms with average carpet area of 36 Sqm. Institute has sufficient unused carpet area for converting into additional classrooms for any future needs.

Computer Center: Institute has two air-conditioned computer labs with carpet area of 200 Sqm with 150 Computers including 3 servers and 8 Laptops. The computer labs are equipped with the state-of-the-art computing resources to cater to the Academic / Training / Administrative needs of the Institute. The computer labs are equipped with LAN, internet and latest software. As there is a thrust on computer knowledge and expertise in the MBA & training programs, all labs are equipped with LCD for Presentation.

Library: The Institute has built up an extensive resource centre for management studies and research. The library of the Institute has, at present, a select list of about 14365 books on different subjects related to Management, Computers, Economics, Commerce, Co-operation, Law, Finance, Banking, Projects, series of Encyclopedia, important References etc. Besides, there are around 250 subjects specific CDs/ Floppies/ Video Cassettes. It also subscribes around

38 journals / periodicals and 11 national and state level newspapers. Books on all subjects of the MBA syllabus are available in the library in more than sufficient numbers.

Auditorium / Seminar Hall: The Institute has one centrally air conditioned auditorium with average carpet area of 1200 Sqm. and seating capacity of 218 seats, well equipped with technical aid to organize seminar and inter college competitions. The Institute has one centrally air conditioned seminar hall with average carpet area of 132 Sqm. and with a seating capacity of 75-90 persons.

Hostel: Well-furnished boarding and lodging facilities are available in the campus separately for boys and girls. At present, the Institute has boys hostel with the capacity of 150 (50 seats are reserved trainees) and girls hostel with capacity of 50 girls on twin sharing and triple sharing basis. All rooms are well furnished with bed, mattress, wardrobe, study table & chair etc. There is arrangement for washing machine, water purifiers with RO & Boilers etc. There are separate common rooms for boys and girls with carpet area of 76 sqm each. The residential facility to residential training and workshop is available for 50 participants in each batch.

Sports: Indoor and outdoor games and recreational facilities are also available in the campus.

Canteen/ Mess: The institute has mess facility with quality food.

Bank: The institute has an extension branch of District Co-operative Bank in the campus.
